1. Can personality traits influence dining habits in children? Our new study says yes!
2. Children who are introverted are less likely to be influenced by environmental cues and are found to serve themselves the same amount of cereal regardless of the size of the bowl.
3. Extroverted children, who are more influenced by external cues, serve themselves 33% more cereal when bowl size is increased.
4. Interestingly, when the serving responsibility is transferred to another person, introverted children become more likely to underestimate how much is being given to them and inadvertently ask for more.
5. Because introverted children measure portion size more accurately when they serve themselves, allow them to do so.
6. Alternately, extroverted children may benefit from being served a measured portion size.
